MONEYSENSE WORKSHOP WITH ULSTER BANK

On Wednesday of the coming week Primary 5 and 6 pupils will participate in 'Moneysense' workshops. The workshops will be led by class teachers but will be assisted by volunteers from the world of banking.

So what is 'Moneysense'?

'Moneysense' is a free financial educational programme for 5-18 year olds. It aims to guide young people towards a better financial future using key money moments in a young person's life e.g. starting to save pocket money, opening a bank account or getting his or her first mobile phone, to make learning about money feel relatable. Parents can access the programme for free where activities, games and videos for all ages are available. Simply google Moneysense and register.

ELECTION OF PARENT GOVERNOR

We are seeking to appoint a new parent governor to the school's Board of Governors. In order to be considered for this voluntary position, you must be a parent/guardian of a pupil presently attending our school. You must also be prepared to remain on the Board of Governors for one term (4 years.)

If you are interested in becoming a Parent Governor, you need to collect a nomination form from the school office and get two other parents to nominate you. In the event of two or more candidates being nominated, then an election will take place among all the parents to decide who the new parent governor will be. All nomination forms will be returned to the school office by Friday 5th October 2018.
