#### **MATHS AND ENGLISH P6**

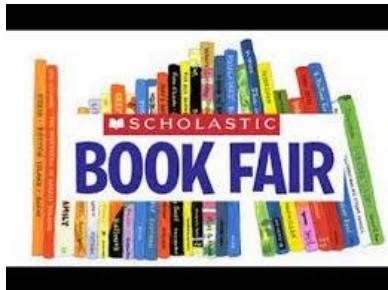
